Operation

Charging the battery

The battery must be fully charged before first use. See page 5 for instructions.

Using the battery

After fully charging the battery, connect it to the garment using the USB-C cable inside the left pocket for vests and jackets, and the right pocket for shorts.

Finding the control button

The control button (1) is located on the bottomleft side for vests and jackets (2), and on the right leg (3) for shorts.

Controling your heated garment

To power on or off, press and hold the button for 3 seconds.

To change the temperature, press the button once.

Three (3) heat levels

High - Red light Normal - Orange light Low - Yellow light





Garment

Care and safety

- Do not wear on bare skin. Always wear a base layer under the heated garment.
- Never use third-party accessories.
- Only use batteries with a USB-C port supporting PD 18W (12 V / 1.5 A).
- Do not modify in any way.
- Never use if the outside temperature is above 20 °C (70 °F).
- Not intended for use by children or incapacitated individuals.
- Never use in an oxygen-enriched environment.
- Never use if there are broken wires or damaged parts.
- Immediately stop use if you experience skin irritation or discomfort.
- Ensure the garment is dry before use.
- Turn off power before charging.
- Never wear the garment while charging.
- Turn off power after use.

Wash instructions

- Remove the battery before washing.
- Wash in cold water.
- Use a delicate/gentle cycle.
- Hang to dry.
- Do not dry clean.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not iron.
- Do not tumble dry.
- · Do not wring.

Maximizing performance in cold weather

Heated garments work best when worn close to the body over a thin base layer.

For extra warmth, wear an insulating outer layer.

Turn off the garment when not in use to preserve battery life.

Battery

Care and safety

- The battery must be fully charged before first use.
- Always remove the battery from the garment pocket before charging.
- Disconnect the battery when not in use for extended periods.
- Ensure the battery is fully charged before storing.
- Warm the battery to a temperature above 10 °C (50 °F) before charging.
- Unplug the charger once the battery is fully charged.
- At cold temperatures, lithium batteries provide reduced capacity.
- Never use the battery if it shows swelling, damage, or if it overheats during charging.
- The battery lifespan is approximately 300 cycles.

Charging the battery

- Remove the battery from the garment and charge it using a USB-C charger.
- For optimal charging performance, use a fast-charging USB-C charger.
